HANDBELL WORKSHOP

Every so often, we hold a summer handbell "workshop" to train new ringers and to allow the veteran ringers the opportunity to review and learn new techniques. **Right now, we are actively looking for new ringers.** If you have any music background and have basic music reading skills, you will be able to be a successful handbell ringer. This workshop would be perfect for anyone considering ringing but have never rung before (or, it has been a long time since you last rung).
